Etiquette

All players must be fully conversant with the course etiquette and the rules of golf. Players must each have their own set of golf clubs and two players playing from one bag is not permitted.

Dress Code

1. Recognised golf shoes must be worn.
2. All shirts must have a collar and may not be removed. The wearing of collarless T-shirts is not permitted.
3. No blue denim or track suits are permitted as they are not considered suitable attire.
4. Shorts must be tailored with belt loops and have a fly or zip (not elastic waist).
5. Shorts must not be more than six inches above the knee. The wearing of shorts is not permitted in the restaurant after 7.00pm.
6. Wet or soiled clothing is allowed in the spike bar only.
7. Trainers may only be worn in the spike bar or patio area.
8. A change of clothing from your golfing attire is requested for the evening.
9. Jacket and ties are not compulsory but smart casual dress is required with either a collar or roll-neck.
